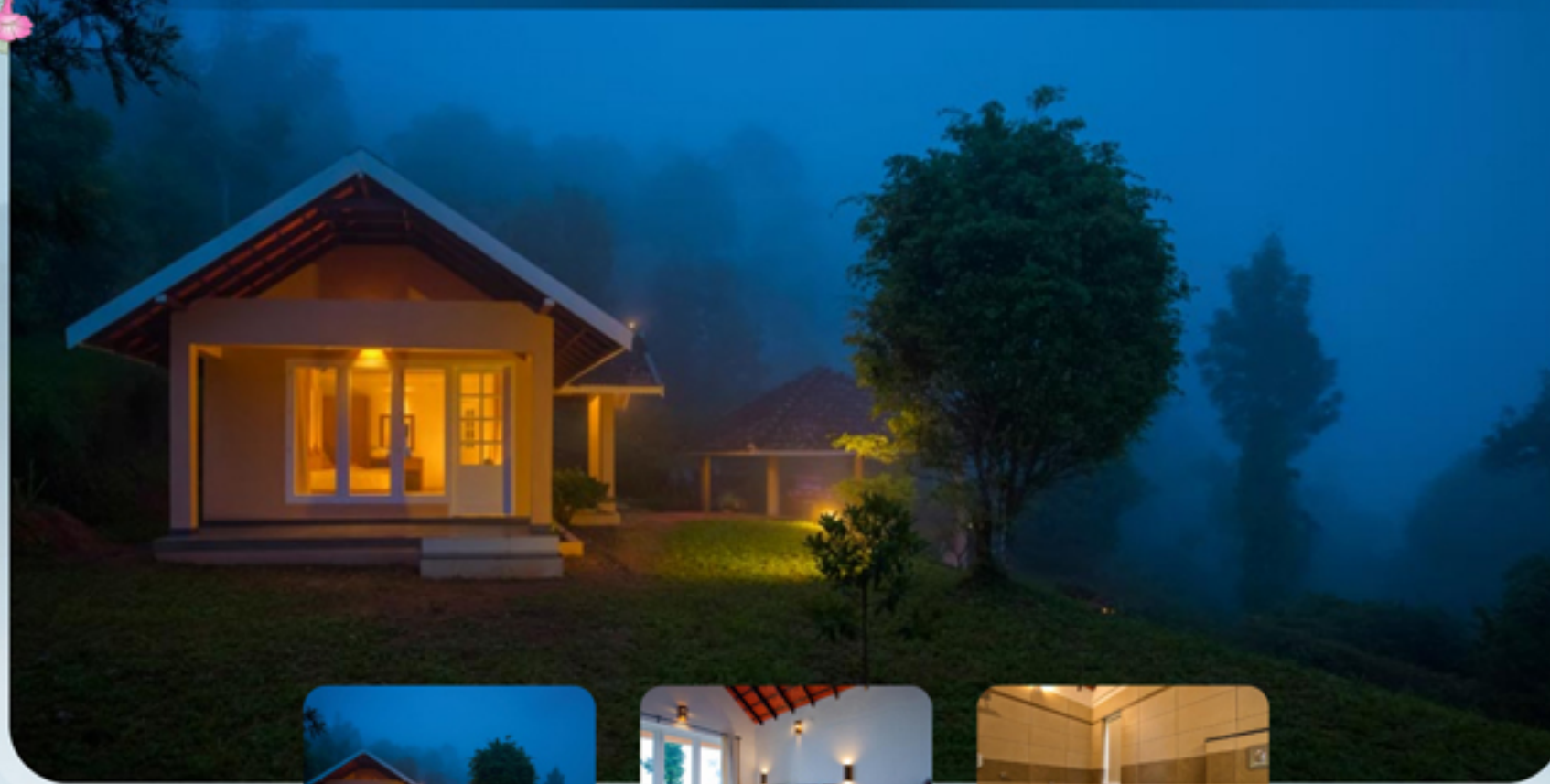

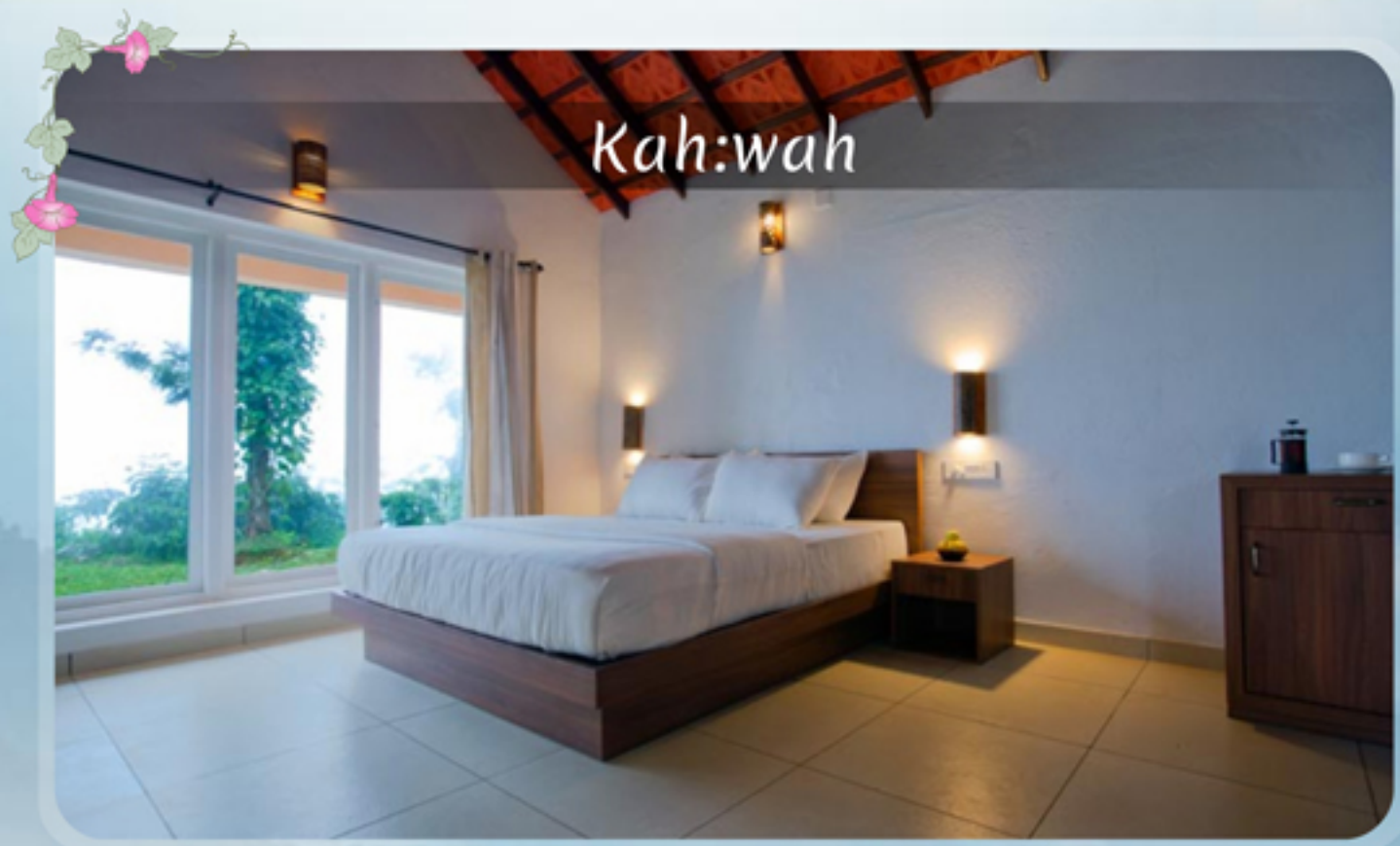

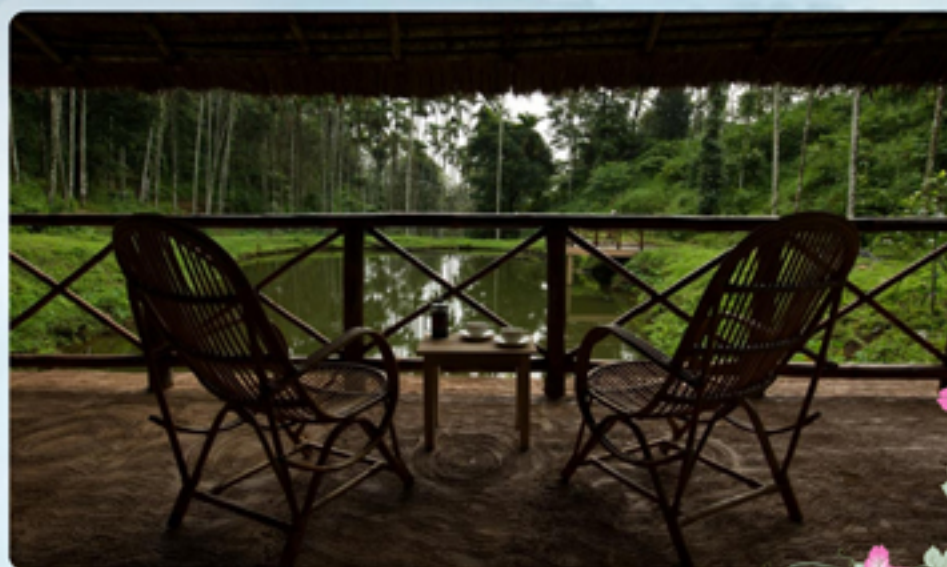

"Ente Uru" - with Ramu

Ramu, our neighbor belongs to the 'Paniya' tribe and is a part time forest guard. He has not been anywhere apart from the forests of Meppadi and Kalpetta. When he is available, Ramu escorts the guests for a visit to the nearby villages.

"ENTE URU" is a trekking experience where you can choose between trekking a sprawling tea estate planted by the British or touring the Kadachikunnu- Valathoor villages to discover the life, landscape and rhythm of the areas.



A Day with Paul

Paul is a farmer by heart and profession. He is the life and soul of the agricultural activities at After The Rains. A DAY WITH PAUL is an exclusive farming activity where you are encouraged to step into the footsteps of a farmer and work in our plantation for a short period of time. At our plantation of Coffee, Pepper, Nutmeg, Cocoa, Fruit trees and Diary learn from Paul the difference between an Arabica and robusta. Observe how honey is taken from the comb, pluck pepper corns and discover the transformation of coffee from bean to cup.

Bicycling Trials

Be an adventurer, explore the rural environs of Puthukkad, Valathoor and Kaanthampara in a mountain bike. We have developed bicycling trials in which guests are provided with routes ranging from the scenic Kaanthampara waterfalls to the village environs in which the resort is located. You can also be an explorer and discover the local life on your own.

Agriculture

After the Rains sits on a bountiful sixteen acre estate in a tropical rainforest, where nature is lush and perennially green. The predominant crops are coffee (robusta) and pepper. We also have cocoa, nutmeg, cardamom, cloves as well as various kinds of fruit trees including mango, jackfruit tree, sapotta, lemon tree, kokum tree, mangostein and chamba trees. The estate is vegetated with lots of trees and shrubs apart from flowering plants and vines. We follow organic practices in farming and use the organic fertilizers made from our own cow stables and goat farms. We produce panchagavyam and jeevamrutham, two excellent sources of plant nutrition which are applied thrice every year. There are also a few colonies of bee hives, meant for honey production. We have our vegetable garden from where the chef can pluck fresh spices and leaves for the days kitchen.

As an area which receives high rainfall and adequate sunlight depending upon the season, the land is fertile and ideal for coffee production. At After the rains, an average of 2500 kg of coffee is produced each year from around 6000 coffee plants. The wastage occurred in the process of roasting the coffee bean is used as manure for plants.

Pepper

Also known as the 'King of spices', an average of 300 kgs of pepper is produced annually. The produce is used within the resort and the rest is sold in the local market. Apart from being a spice, pepper has antibacterial and antioxidant properties. It is an amazing medicine and helps in treating cough, cold, intestinal problems and even cancer. The wastage in the process of crushing pepper is used as a natural fertilizer for plants as it helps in maintaining the humidity.



Areca Nut

950 areca nut trees can be found in the plantation of After the Rains resort. We produce an average of 4000 kgs of areca nut each year. Areca nut obtained is sold in the market. Areca nut has a number of uses including its usage in - dyeing of fabrics, food colour and medicinal production.



Cocoa

Extensively used in making chocolates, drinks and medicines the cocoa produce of the plantation comes to an average of 100 kgs annually. Powdered cocoa is used within the resort. Cocoa plants need hot and humid tropical conditions to give the best harvest. Cocoa is also popular for its uses in the skin.

Diary

The plantation also grows cattle through which the diary requirements of the resort are met. The milk obtained is used at the resort and the remaining is sold to the nearby co-operative society. Cow dung and goat dung is used as manure for our crops and plants. Our cattle make the plantation lively and is treated as a part of the After the rains family.



Fruit Trees

At the plantation you can find trees of jack fruit, mangoes, avocado, rambutan, mangos teen and creepers of passion fruit. We always try to offer the plantation fruits to our guests during the meal time's depending upon the season. Fruits are offered in the guest rooms as well by the season of the produce.



Honey

Honey bee cultivation and organic farming is done at After the rains. Honey bee boxes that contain bee combs are a part of the plantation. Cool climatic conditions are a necessity for better production of honey, making honey a seasonal product. The best season for honey cultivation is from the beginning of November to mid-February. The bee's feed on our flowers, coffee plants and fruit trees for making honey. Bee wax, powder of flowers and other byproducts of honey cultivation are sold in local markets.





Dining

Inspired by the region, Ahua which means nature in Maori is our all day dining area, where you can indulge in a variety of local flavors from around the region. The concept of Ahua is to eat local and think global. Be it the seasonal fresh fruits, the plantation produce, the sumptuous Kizhisadhya or the delicious paayasam, Ahua never lets down anyone willing to try out local flavors of Wayanad. At After The Rains, we try to meet our requirements of milk, eggs, honey, spices and fruits from our own farms.

Being the most important meal of the day, breakfast is a careful selection of buffet and Table D'outh. The buffet offers you varieties of fresh breads, fruit platters, homemade granola, cereals, flavored yoghurts, exotic preserves, eggs to order and many more. South Indian breakfast is served on the table depending upon the menu of the particular day. Guests can taste popular delicacies like Kallappam with chicken ishtew as well as the puttlu filled with rice flakes and finely grated coconut accompanied by thick gravy of chick peas or vegetable uttappams, thattudosas and steaming idlis with a wide range of chutneys.





Dining

Freshly grounded coffee from our plantation and piping hot tea from the colonial tea estates of Rippon is bound to make your day fit for a summiteer.

Dinner is the most exclusive treat, where the meals served include broths, garden fresh salads, lentils, platters of meat and vegetables cooked in regional flavors to delight your senses. Hung curd and in house pickles are the main accompaniments. Dishes made from tomatoes, spinach, cottage cheese and gram flour cater for vegetarian taste buds. Rice and roti are in a good variety and differ with the day's menu. For the meat lovers, chicken cooked in Indian masal's covered with banana leaf, Malabar fish curry cooked in thick gravy of coconut milk, kodavapandi curry or the kuttanadankozhiperalan are some of our highly recommendable dishes that alternatively form part of the menu. Barbeques are done on special days depending upon the weather conditions. A tempting selection of chilled soups, platters of charcoal grilled and spit roasted chicken, meat and fish, skewers of grilled vegetables and caramelized fruits help you to wrap up your day of adventure.
